GRAFTON SHOWGROUND VISITORS, STAFF & VOLUNTEERS

- COVID-19 INFORMATION & REQUIREMENTS

- Please observe COVID-19 social distancing requirements of one person per 4 square metres with a minimum of 1.5 m between each person at all times.
- All campers must register with the caretaker before entering the Showground. Campers must complete the campers' registration form and ensure their campsite adheres to social distancing requirements.
- Members and guests of any licenced Showground user group must provide their name and contact details in the group's visitor register. Visitor register is to be retained for 28 days.
- All other visitors, staff and volunteers must provide their name and contact details to the caretaker.
- It is the responsibility of Showground user groups and hirees of Showground facilities to ensure that social distancing requirements are adhered to.
- Outdoor gatherings are limited to a maximum of 20 people per group (maximum of 500 people).
- Funerals are permitted to have up to 100 guests. Venue hirees are to ensure social distancing requirements are adhered to.
- Weddings are permitted to have up to 150 guests. Venue hirees are to ensure social distancing requirements are adhered to.
- Hirees of Showground facilities must ensure alcohol is served to seated patrons only.
- Hirees of Showground facilities are requested to advise guests to disperse at the conclusion of the event to ensure required social distancing and avoid crowding .

- When using Showground amenities, please observe good hand hygiene practice by washing hands with soap provided (or using your own hand sanitiser), using disposable paper hand towels and placing used paper towels in bins provided.
- If you have symptoms, or develop symptoms consistent with COVID-19 you must immediately be tested and self-isolate until you have received the results of your test. There is a free COVID-19 testing clinic at Grafton Hospital, Arthur Street, Grafton. Campers awaiting test results must self-isolate in an area of the Showground designated by the Showground Caretaker.
- It is recommended that you download the COVIDSafe app onto your phone as this will assist contact tracing in the event you come in contact with an infected person.
- Travel restrictions are in place for the following vulnerable communities in the Clarence Valley Council area:
 - all aged care facilities (please check with individual facilities for specific restrictions)
 - local indigenous communities
