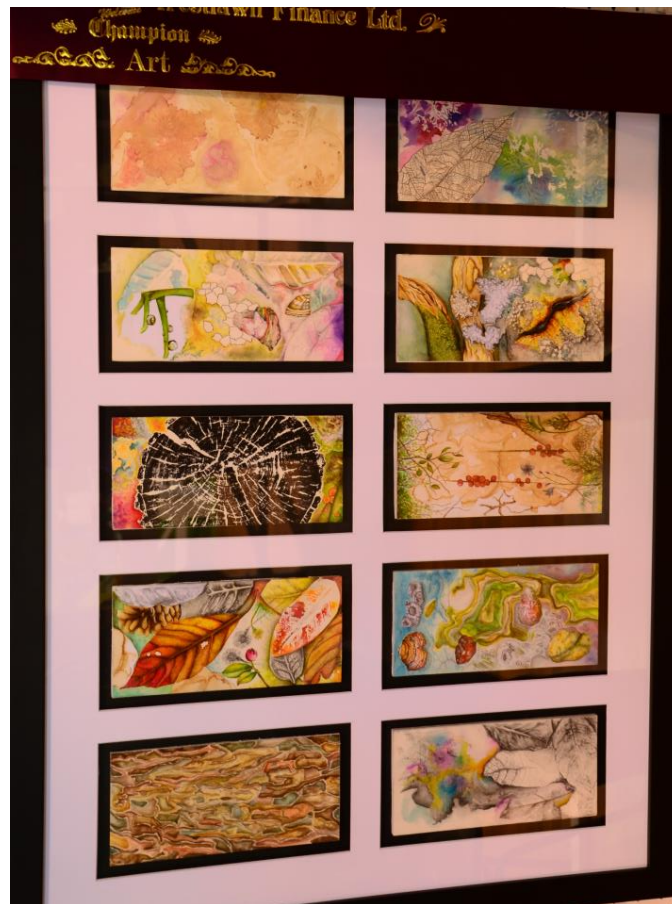

- Online entries by Friday, 29th April 2022, 4:30pm. <https://showday.online/show/grafton>
- Manual entries, please lodge entry forms and obtain exhibit entry tickets between 9.00am and 4.00pm on Wednesday, 27th April, Thursday, 28th April and Friday 29th April 2022.
- Art exhibits must be delivered to the Pavilion between 9.00am and 4.30pm Friday, 29th April 2022.
- All exhibits must be the original work of the exhibitor within the past 2 years and not previously have won a prize at a Grafton Show.
- Exhibits must not exceed 1000mm x 1000mm.
- Limit of one exhibit per person per class.
- All exhibits must be suitably presented with wire/cord fixed for hanging.
- Exhibits to be hung at the discretion of the Chief Steward.
- Definition of Still Life is fruit, flowers, pottery, not human face or figure, nor depicting action.
- Dye pen or airbrush will not be accepted in any class other than the specific dye pen/airbrush class.
- No photocopied, computer generated or technologically assisted work accepted.
- Work with loose glitter will not be accepted.
- Pavilion exhibits to be collected on Sunday, 8th May 2022, between 1.00pm and 4.00pm or Monday, 9th May 2022, between 9.30am and 11.00am
- Prize money not collected by 12 noon Monday 26th April 2021 will be forfeited to Grafton Show.
