- Manual entries, please lodge entry forms and obtain exhibit entry tickets between 9.00 am and 3.30 pm from Tuesday, 26th April 2022 to Wednesday, 27th April 2022.
- Exhibits must be delivered to the Pavilion from Tuesday, 26th April 2022, to Thursday, 28th April 2022, 9am to 3.30pm or Friday, 29th April 2022, from 9.00 am to 12noon.

ENTRY FEE

- \$2.00 per exhibit

SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR CRAFT

- All exhibits and mountings must be in unsoiled and undamaged conditions.
- All exhibits must have been completed by the exhibitor within the last 12 months and not exhibited at a previous Grafton Show.
- Craft exhibits are to be no longer/heavier than one person is able to carry.
- Classes are open to all exhibitors except where stated.
- Exhibits that are not clean will not be judged.
- Framed exhibits must be presented ready for hanging.
- Definition - Novice - open to any exhibitor who has been learning for less than 12 months and not won a prize in any Grafton Show.
- Prize money, Ribbons and cards will be awarded for 1st and 2nd placings in each class.
- Sashes will be awarded for Champion Exhibits at the Judge's Discretion.
- Craft exhibits to be collected on Sunday, 8th May 2022 between 1:00pm and 4:00pm or Monday, 9th May 2022 between 9:30am and 11:00am.
- Prize money not collected by 11:00am Monday, 9th May 2022 will be forfeited to the Grafton Show.
