- No portion of a collection may compete as a single exhibit
- All Special Awards by Point Score to be decided by the Stewards. Points will be allocated as follows; 1st = 2 points, 2nd = 1 points
- Junior section – for children under 12 years of age

### **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- Organically grown produce is welcome.
- Late entries will not be accepted.
- Exhibits are not to be removed during the Show.
- Exhibits entered in a wrong class may be transferred at the discretion of the Chief Steward.
- The Chief Steward has the right to accept or refuse any exhibit.
- The Chief Steward's decision regarding the removal of an exhibit or exhibitor from the Showground will be final.
- In all matters regarding exhibits and exhibitors in the Produce Pavilion, the decision of the Chief Steward of the Produce Pavilion is final.
- If there are only two entries in a class, second place will be awarded at the discretion of the Judge.
- Results of judging will not be available prior to the first day of the Show.
- Entries must be in marketable condition unless otherwise stated.
- All exhibits shall remain the property of the exhibitor.
- Permission is assumed to reproduce any exhibit for publicity purposes.
- Every care will be taken with exhibits but no responsibility will be accepted.
- Produce Pavilion exhibits may be collected on Sunday, 8th May 2022, from 1.00 pm - 5.00 pm; or Monday, 9th May 2022, from 9.00 am to 11.00 am.
- Exhibitors may also choose not to collect their entry.
- Prize money not collected by Monday, 9th May 2022, will be forfeited to Grafton Show.
