- Exhibits must be delivered to the Pavilion from 9:00am to 10:30am, Thursday, 5th May 2022.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR FLORAL ART

- Maximum bench space allowed 600mm.
- Any embellishment accepted.
- Artificial materials are not allowed.

DEFINITIONS

- Open - open to any exhibitors who have won 2 prizes in Intermediate at any Grafton Show.
- Intermediate - open to any exhibitor who have won 2 prizes in Novice at any Grafton Show.
- Novice - open to any exhibitor who has not won a prize at any Grafton Show.
- Junior - Secondary (open to students in years 7 - 12).
- Junior - Primary (open to students in or below year 2).
- Junior - Infants (open to students in or below year 2).
- Bowl - a bowl is wider than it is high.
- Vase - a vase is higher than it is wide.
- Non-traditional container - any container other than a bowl or vase.
