CLOSING DATE AND DELIVERY OF EXHIBITS

- Online entries close Friday, 29th April 2022, 12noon. <https://showday.online/show/Grafton>
- Manual entries, please lodge entry forms and obtain exhibit entry tickets between 9.00 am and 3.30 pm from Tuesday, 26th April 2022 to Wednesday, 27th April 2022.
- Exhibits must be delivered to the Pavilion from Tuesday, 26th April 2022, to Thursday, 28th April 2022, 9am to 3.30pm or Friday, 29th April 2022, from 9.00 am to 12noon.

ENTRY FEE

- \$2.00 per exhibit.

KNITTED or CROCHET SQUARES

- When entering knitted/crochet squares, exhibitors may choose to donate their article to Warm Touch 2460 to be made into rugs for those in need.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR NEEDLEWORK

- Limited to two entries per exhibitor per class.
- All exhibits and mountings must be in unsoiled and undamaged condition.
- All Needlework exhibits must be in unsoiled condition and neatly pressed.
- Doilies are to be half mounted on coloured cardboard.
- Exhibits that are not clean will not be judged.
- Tapestries will be awarded on front work only.
- Framed exhibits must be presented ready to hang.
- All exhibits must have been completed by the exhibitor within the last 2 years and not exhibited at a previous Grafton Show.
- Classes are open to all exhibitors except where stated.
- Definition: Novice – open to any exhibitor who has been learning for less than 12 months and not won a prize at any Grafton Show.
- Ribbons & cards will be awarded for 1st and 2nd placing in each class. Sashes will be awarded for Champion Exhibits where stated.
- Needlework exhibits to be collected on Sunday, 8th May 2022, between 1.00 pm and 4.00 pm or Monday, 9th May 2022, between 9.30 am and 11.00 am.
- Prize money not collected by 11.00 am Monday, 9th May 2022, will be forfeited to Grafton Show.
