GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR ALL ARTS & CRAFTS

Open classes are open to all ages, unless stated.

Exhibits are not to be removed during the show.

Exhibits entered in a wrong class may be transferred at the discretion of the Chief Steward.

The Chief Steward has the right to accept or refuse any exhibit.

The Chief Stewards decision regarding the removal of an exhibit or exhibitor from the showground will be final.

In all matters regarding exhibits and exhibitors in the Pavilion, the decision of the Chief Steward of the Pavilion is final.

If there are only two entries in a class, second place will be awarded at the discretion of the judge.

Results of judging will not be available prior to the first day of the Show.

Entries must be in marketable condition unless otherwise stated.

All exhibits shall remain the property of the exhibitor.

Permission is assumed to reproduce any exhibit for publicity purposes.

Every care will be taken with exhibits but no responsibility will be accepted.

Any exhibit not collected by Friday 5th May, 2023, will be disposed of.

CHIEF STEWARDS AWARD

In each area in the pavilion the chief steward can present a special award, the Chief Steward Award. This is presented at the discretion of the chief steward, to an exhibit they feel deserved a prize but was not awarded one by the judge.

MOST SUCCESSFUL JUNIOR EXHIBITOR BY POINT SCORE

2023 annual trophy for the Most Successful Junior Exhibitor in the Pavilion - This will include all areas of the Pavilion, so if you enter a number of different areas, your placings from each of those areas will count towards the trophy. Points will be awarded as follows - 1st place = 2 points, 2nd place = 1 point. The winner will be the exhibitor with the highest total score.

- Exhibits must be delivered to the stewards at the T J Ford Pavilion from Tuesday 18th April 2023 to Thursday 20th April 2023, from 10am - 4pm or Friday 21st April, 10am - 12 noon.
- Entry fee \$2 per exhibit
- All exhibits and mountings must be unsoiled and in undamaged condition.
- All exhibits must have been completed by the exhibitor in the last 2 years and not exhibited at a previous Grafton Show.
- Classes are open to all exhibitors except where stated.
- Novice - open to any exhibitor who has been learning less than 12 months and not won a prize in any Grafton Show.
- Keep exhibits true to class. eg if there is a class listed for your item, enter it in that class, not "any other subject"
- Collect exhibits Sunday 30th April 2023, 10am - 4pm or Monday 1st May 2023, 10.00am - 1.00pm.
- Ribbons awarded for 1st and 2nd in class, Most Outstanding Exhibit and Champions.
