- Any exhibits that are not collected will be taken to the Show Office and can be collected on Wednesdays and Fridays from 9.30 am to 2.30 pm.
- **ANY EXHIBIT NOT COLLECTED BY FRIDAY 24<sup>th</sup> May 2025 (WITHIN 14 DAYS OF THE SHOW) WILL BE DISPOSED OF.**

### **CHIEF STEWARD'S AWARD**

In each area of the Pavilion, the Chief Steward can present a Special Award, "Chief Steward's Award." This is presented at the discretion of the Chief Steward to an exhibit they feel deserved a prize but was not awarded one by the Judges.

### **MOST SUCCESSFUL JUNIOR EXHIBITOR BY POINT SCORE**

The 2025 trophy for the "Most Successful Junior Exhibitor in the Pavilion" This will include all areas of the Pavilion, so if you enter a number of different areas, your placings from each of those areas will count towards the trophy. - The exhibitor must own plants for at least six months
- Plants are ineligible if they have won a prize in the previous Grafton Show


