Horse Section Regulations

GATE ENTRY TICKETS - All people entering the grounds must have a gate entry ticket. Entry tickets can be pre-purchased at a discount rate prior to 25th April 2026 by following this link:
<https://www.123tix.com.au/events/42504/grafton-show-2026>

Tickets purchased online will be \$18/adult, \$8/child. After this date, no discount applies. Anyone arriving at the grounds without a gate ticket will be charged full-price entry.

VEHICLE ENTRY PASS - Vehicle entry passes will be emailed to competitors who pay for camping, with their confirmation of entries. Competitors can either print the pass and bring it with them or have it on their phone to show at the gate. Vehicles without a pass will not be allowed in the grounds and must park in the day parking area in Villiers St

ENTRY FEE Entry Fee \$6 per class unless specified-

LATE ENTRIES. A competitor must have entered an online class before the closing date. They will then be allowed to enter on the day. Late entries must be lodged at the horse office between 7am and 8am. Showjumping entries and stabling and camping fees are to be paid via Global entries online.

WAIVER FORM, HORSE DETAILS & PIC NUMBERS - Livestock waivers are to be completed Online via Global Entries when you complete your entries.

REGISTRATION PAPERS - exhibits in Registered Breed Classes must be registered and competitors must present papers to Stewards on request, exhibits must be owned by a current financial member of their Breed Society

HEIGHT CERTIFICATES - All Ponies, Galloways and Hacks to present a Height Certificate issued at this Show by the official Measurer, or, a current Equestrian Australia (EA) or Hack Council Height Certificate may be accepted. Some horses nearing the expiration of their EA certificate, at the discretion of the judge, may be requested to be measured by Grafton Show's Official Measurer. Grafton Show Official Measurer will be available on the grounds on Friday & Saturday

HEIGHT DEFINITIONS -

- Ponies - not to exceed 14 hands (not to exceed 14.2 hands in some breed classes)
- Galloways - over 14 hands and not exceeding 15 hands
- Hacks - over 15 hands

ALL HORSES MUST TAKE PART IN THE GRAND PARADE

Only ribbons won at the current Grafton Show shall be exhibited in the Grand Parade Consolation classes - no entry fee or prize money, ribbons only

PRIZE MONEY - 1st - \$10, 2nd - \$5, 3rd - ribbon except for sponsored classes

Prize winners may choose to collect a raffle ticket in lieu of a ribbon (the Ring Steward must be advised prior so the ribbon does not get placed on the horse) 1st \$50, 2nd \$30, 3rd \$20 - Drawn Saturday afternoon after the Grand Parade Prize Money and ribbons awarded - where there is only one or two horses in an event, only 1st prize money will be awarded. Ribbons will be awarded to third-place Prize Money is to be collected from the Show Office throughout the day before 4.00 pm Saturday 25th April 2026. (PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND THE SHOW OFFICE UNLESS YOU HAVE COLLECTED ALL YOUR PRIZE TICKETS)

Prize tickets are not redeemable for sideshow attractions.

Prize money not collected by 4pm Saturday evening of the show will be forfeited to Grafton Show

Entries are made subject to the Society's rules and the rules and regulations of the Far North Coast Agricultural Society Group and RAS rules.

Horse Section Regulations

Random Drug Testing horse owners and exhibitors are hereby notified that their animals may be subjected to Random Drug Testing by a suitably qualified person at any time during the show

Headwear is compulsory for all riders and must comply with current standards as set down in Equestrian Australia Regulations or as per breed dress regulations

Footwear - all persons entering the main ring, including assistants, must wear appropriate covered footwear
Prams, strollers, chairs, trolleys, dogs, alcohol - are not permitted in the main ring

Mobile phones to be switched to silent mode

Ring events are under the control of the Chief Steward If the number of entries warrants, classes may be split at the discretion of the Chief Steward

Removal of exhibit or exhibitor - the Chief Steward's decision regarding the removal of an exhibit or exhibitor from the judging area or the showground is final

Improper behaviour - any persons being abusive or offensive to a Judge or Steward will be disqualified from competing at this or any future Grafton Show

Protests must be delivered to the Chief Ring Steward, at the Horse Office, in writing within half an hour after an award has been made, with a deposit of one hundred dollars (\$100) which may be forfeited if the protest is dismissed. No persons are to approach Judges or Officials in the ring

Outside assistance to competitors by word, radio or any other method in Horse ring events will not be permitted. If in breach of this ruling, competitors and their exhibits may be dismissed from the event and from the Showground

Wet weather - if the Chief Steward feels that the grounds are too wet he/she will then call a meeting of the Section Chief Stewards to determine if ring events should be cancelled, the majority decision being final. The committee accepts no responsibility to indemnify competitors in any way for events cancelled under such circumstances

Stallions cannot compete with geldings or mares in any class. They can only compete in nominated stallion classes, except in Show Jumping

Colts and stallions in led classes must be exhibited in a stallion or rearing bit (except for western breed classes) and must be handled by a competitor 17 years & over. Green disc to be worn by stallions if this is a breed requirement

Weanlings are not eligible to compete as foal at the side of the dam

Class definitions -

Maiden - a horse that has not won first prize in the type of event nominated at an Agricultural Show, Rodeo, Gymkhana or Sports Meeting

Novice - a horse that has not won a first prize at a Royal Show or an Open Championship at an Agricultural Show. Show Hacks and Show Hunters are combined for the Novice Events

Local - only persons and exhibits who reside in the Local Government area of Clarence Valley Council are eligible to compete

Open Champion - if the 1st place getter in the Open Hack & Open Hunter does not present for Open Champion the 2nd place getter is eligible to compete for the Championship at the discretion of the Judge Adult's Hack must be ridden by a rider 17 Years and over. In Championship events a horse must be ridden by the same rider who rode it to win that restricted class

Show Hunter Hacks can only compete in Hunter Classes and not the Open Hack classes

Supreme Champion Open Hack - only Open Hack, Galloway Hack and Pony Hack Champion winners are eligible to compete for Supreme Champion Open Hack

Supreme Show Hunter Hack - only Show Hunter Hack, Galloway Show Hunter Hack and Pony Show Hunter Hack Champion winners are eligible to compete for Supreme Show Hunter Hack

Registration papers and current financial membership must be shown to the Steward upon request. Anyone unable to do so will not be allowed to compete




